SHOW RULES

1. This show is sanctioned by ADGA and their rules shall govern. The Junior and Senior Doe Shows are separately sanctioned. The Junior and Senior buck shows are sanctioned as one.
2. The show is sanctioned for the following breeds: Alpine, LaMancha, Nigerian Dwarf, Nubian, Oberhasli, Saanen, Sable Saanen, Toggenburg & Recorded Grade
3. The Buck shows on Saturday June 26, 2021 are sanctioned for the following breeds: LaMancha, Nigerian Dwarf, Nubian & AOP. Shows will be back to back.
4. The base date of the show is June 26 & June 27, 2021.
5. The original registration certification is required for all animals six months of age or older. Animals under six months of age may be shown with stamped, duplicate applications.
6. All goats out of state must carry an official health certificate from state of origin. **ALL HEALTH PAPERS MUST INCLUDE YOUR FEDERAL SCAPIE ID NUMBER.** Health papers will be checked by a member of the show committee. All goats must have a premise ID number. No animals will be unloaded before 4 P.M. EDST on June 25, 2021. Animals showing signs of infectious disease or ill health will be barred from the barns and show arena.
7. Pens will be assigned as entries are received. An assignment chart will be posted.
8. No horned animals will be allowed.
9. ABSOLUTELY NO DOGS allowed in the barn or show facilities!
10. There will be no pre-show milkout.
11. Registration desk will be open from 5 P.M. to 10 P.M. EDST Friday and Saturday evening to accept entries and prior to the show until 7:30 A.M. on Saturday and Sunday morning.
12. Champion of Breed MUST STAY for Best of Show.
13. The Noble County Community Fair, nor any individual associated with this organization or show will be held responsible for loss, damage, or accident to any person, animals or property. All animals are entered in the show at the owner's risk. Camping sites available for \$30 per night.
14. Show is subject to change.
