## Rules and Requirements

Hoosier Classic is an official ADGA show and ADGA rules shall govern. The junior and senior doe show is separately sanctioned. ADGA rules shall govern, and the show committee has the right to change or add to the show rules as needed. We will follow the ADGA stamped duplicate policy at the time of the show. The base date for all shows will be June 10, 2023. Showmanship base date is May 1, 2023. Show order is subject to change. It will be the exhibitor's responsibility to be present for the class unless the Show Chairman (not the ring steward) has been advised differently. The show will proceed uninterrupted so bring plenty of help. The judges and show secretaries will be switching rings. Sanctioning breeds: Alpine, AOP (Guernsey and Saanen), LaMancha, Nigerian Dwarf, Nubian, Oberhasli, Recorded Grade, Sable and Toggenburg. Show Chairman and Judges decisions are final.

Late fee starts June 9, 2023, at 12:00am – \$10 per animal per ring

### **Pens**

Pens will be assigned by show chairman. Exhibitors may show from trailers.

Pens - \$6 per animal and tack pen for the weekend. Make pen requests via Showman App.

Bedding and hay will be provided for a fee via Showman App.

Pen availability for late entries cannot be guaranteed.

Pen maps will be posted on the Hoosier Classic ADGA Show Facebook page. Pen maps will also be posted in the barns.

### **Arrival and Check-In**

The committee will be available to accept dairy goats starting Friday, June 9, 2023, at 1:00pm unless prior arrangements for early arrival have been made with the chairman.

Check-in is available Friday from 4:00pm to 10:00pm, Saturday and Sunday 6:00am-7:00am and Saturday evening 8:00pm-10:00pm. You must be checked in by 7:00am on the day of the show. The Indiana Dairy Goat Association Inc., the directors or the Hendricks County Fairgrounds will not be responsible for any losses, damages, or accidents which could result in personal loss or injury. No dogs and no smoking in the barns.

Camping is permitted in and around the barns.

Trailer hook-up (include electric, water and sewer) are available on a first come first service basis. There is a \$20 charge per night. You will secure this spot through the Showman App and will be assigned. Make any requests via Showman App.

### **Health Requirements**

Out-of-state dairy goats must have health certificates signed by their vet's office. In-state animals do not need health papers. Animals showing signs of illness or disease must be removed from the fairgrounds.

No unloading of animals until you have been approved by one of the committee members.

- Intermediate kids – born March 1<sup>st</sup> to March 31<sup>st</sup> of current year
- Senior kid – born January 1<sup>st</sup> to February 28<sup>th</sup> of current year
- Junior Yearlings (never fresh) – born May 1<sup>st</sup> to December 31<sup>st</sup> of previous year
- Senior Yearlings (never fresh) – born on or before April 30<sup>th</sup> of pervious year and under 2 years of age

- Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion
- Best Junior Doe in Show

#### **Senior Does (as of base date June 10, 2023)**

- Milking Yearling – under 2 years
- Milking Doe – 2 years and under 3 years
- Milking Doe – 3 years and under 4 years
- Milking Doe – 4 years and under 5 years
- Milking Doe – 5 years and over
- Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion
- Champion Challenge – Best of Breed
- Best Udder of Breed
- Best Senior Doe in Show
- Best Udder in Show

- 3-5 year old Buck – 3 years and under 5 years

- Senior Does – Sr Get of Sire, Produce of Dam (2 or 3 include junior does or only senior does) Dairy Herd (4 in milk), Sr Best 3, Best Udder, Sr Dam/Daughter and Breeders Herd (2 Jr/2 Sr).
- Bucks – Sire/Son

### **Sable**

- Junior Does – Jr Get of Sire

- Bucks – Sire/Son
